### CONNECT



### Childcare

Families are encouraged to attend worship services together.
Childcare temporarily not available.



### Safety

Security officer will be on campus in uniform to assist with safety & be our link to resources of the Phoenix PD

### Reopening Phase 2 – Starting June 6th, 2021

- Weekly worship services in FLC & Sanctuary to allow for additional distancing
- English and Chinese-speaking services held at different times
- Following CDC guidance, social distancing required at least 6 feet between each household grouping
- Masks required for everyone (3 yrs+)
- Cleaning conducted prior to and after on all high-touch surfaces and restrooms
- Continued online worship option with services live streamed & viewable later
- All Sunday classes continue to meet virtually for all age groups (no classes or childcare on campus)

### Reopening Phase 3 - Date To Be Announced

- Weekly worship services move to sanctuary
- Sunday classes resume on campus
- Cleaning conducted prior to and after on all high-touch surfaces and restrooms
- Follow CDC guidance on social distancing and mask mandates
- Continued online worship option with services live streamed & viewable later
