I truly appreciate the directness of Brother James. In his small book of instruction to the 12 tribes (numerous house churches), he doesn't write in a soft or compromising manner. Over the years, in order not to offend others, I've heard many Christians refer to various decisions made by people as "mistakes" when, in fact, the proper and honest word might well have been "sin." A mistake is an action that was totally unintentional. A sin, based on God's description and expectation, is a calculated determination to act in a way

that lacks faith or dependence on God's guidance. This is a real challenge for us as it calls each of us to do as Paul says in "praying without ceasing" for our conclusions and behavior.

If you have children in your family, grown or still young, consider them and what you model for them when it comes to dependence on God's influence on your life. Do you make mistakes in life.....of course! Do you sin and disobey God's Will? Unfortunately, that answer is "yes" as well. Let us not confuse "mistakes" and "sins" as we seek to responsibly be honest with ourselves and God by minimizing the "sinful decisions" that we make daily (James 4:17).

The Scripture says that we are all sinners but our getting comfortable with sin is dangerous. Let's all pray more...for the sake of our world!

Reopening Phase 2 – Starting June 6th, 2021

- Masks required for everyone (3 yrs+)
- Cleaning conducted prior to and after on all high-touch surfaces and restrooms
