Hope of Advent

CHRISTMAS IS COMING (Advent Season): This Sunday, we will begin to celebrate our preparation for the Celebration of Christ's birth. On the 3rd of December, we will have brothers and sisters gathering in our building to do what is called "hanging of the green," as we decorate our facilities. The Advent wreath will be used on Sunday as part of our worship service as a circular garland of evergreen branches representing eternity. On that wreath, five candles will be arranged. Each candle represents an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ.

During the season of Advent, one candle on the wreath is lit each Sunday as a part of the Advent services. Families, or other small groups of friends may give devotional readings or prayers while lighting the candles on the Advent wreath. Some Christians may also have this tradition in their homes as a way of focusing their spiritual lives at this time.

On the first Sunday of Advent (Nov. 28, 2021), the first candle (usually purple or blue) is lit. This candle may be called the "Prophecy Candle or Hope Candle" as it reminds us of the Prophecies preparing the way for the Messiah: "Therefore, the Lord Himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and will call Him Immanuel (Is. 7:14)"
