As the 2nd most important and celebrated feast of the Christian Calendar, only following Easter, Christmas is surrounded with the history and peace incorporated in the birth of Jesus Christ. Yet, the commercialism brought by "Black Friday Sales" that come immediately after Thanksgiving impact the meaning and emphasis of what our view of Christmas has become.
