"Do You Share Jesus?"

Some people describe themselves as Christians but have great difficulty organizing their thoughts in telling others how to become a follower of Christ. Many years ago, a simple and concise set of verses were put together called "The Roman Road" and helps give anyone the steps to understanding how to follow Jesus. These verses are all found within one letter (Romans) of Scripture. Let us have a look:

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" - [Romans 3:23](#)

"For the wages of sin is death"... "but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." - [Romans 6:23](#)

"But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." - [Romans 5:8](#)

"If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." - [Romans 10:9](#)

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." [Romans 10:13](#)

*Based on these Scriptures: We are all alike and all are sinners and imperfect. Our sin is that we have not respected God for Lordship in our life. For that selfishness and disrespect of God, we deserve death...eternal death! Yet, God loves us so much that he sent his sinless son, Jesus to die in our place for our sinful behavior. God's only expectation is that we change our pride away from ourselves and openly follow Jesus as our Lord. This means not just knowing about the facts of Jesus but it means we depend on Jesus as the resurrected son of God who lives in our hearts. When we pray and ask forgiveness for our sin, Jesus promises that we are now the true children of Christ as our Savior.

*Simple to understand? Yes, but it requires a person to humble himself/herself and depend on Jesus Christ and many proud people think they know more than even God! Let us realize that we can "save" nobody. However, we can, and must, share the Good News of Jesus with all! He is always listening for our prayer of dependence on Him.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
