As we know, we are not two churches but are one church united in the purpose for serving our Lord. Indeed, since before the Pandemic began, I had been keeping an open eye for any possible Chinese Congregation ministerial possibilities as well. Truly, finding ministers/pastors that match the spiritual needs of our church is not a simple matter and may very well take time. Finding pastors with the elements of Christian Character and Theological Foundation in line with our solid dependence on God's Word (Bible), requires patience and the belief that God will meet our needs!

At this time, our church has been working to select and develop a Pastor Search Committee to guide the effort in seeking future pastoral leadership. With a desire to find both a Senior Pastor and a Mandarin Language Pastor for our congregations, the Pastor Search Committee members require your fervent prayer and support. They will regularly communicate their progress to our church regarding their process to address our church needs and then screen/interview those candidates who have an interest in serving with us. The committee will review the theology, character, burden, ministerial experience/history, and similar things of candidates on our behalf. The Pastor Search Committee will only then provide candidate recommendations for church members to have final approval.

The Pastor Search Committee is comprised of faithful church members that represent various age groups, genders, language, and cultural backgrounds. They have agreed to a covenant that seeks God's guidance, understands/follows our church polity/procedures, satisfies our church needs with the best interests of our total church at heart, and prayerfully recommends pastoral candidates to equip our church to accomplish our mission "to lead people to discover Jesus and live a life of purpose."
