Pastor's Word: CHURCH MEMBERSHIP at FCBC

First Chinese Baptist Church is an autonomous New Testament church that has chosen to unite with the Southern Baptist Convention as a sister church in fellowship and service to our Lord, Jesus Christ. The Southern Baptist Convention is a denominational cooperative body that includes a total of some 50,000 congregations across the United States with partnering church bodies in multiple countries around the world. Membership is obtained in a similar way to what is experienced within other SBC bodies via the primary three options of (1) Baptism, (2) Letter, or (3) Statement of Faith.

- (1) To join FCBC <u>via Baptism</u> means that a person has chosen to profess Christ as their savior and Lord and then requested to follow Christ's command in Matthew 28: 19–20 by being baptized, by immersion, into this church body.
- (2) To join FCBC <u>via Letter</u> means that a person has been a member in good standing of another sister Baptist church and a letter of membership transfer has been received by FCBC from that church.
- (3) To join FCBC <u>via Statement</u> means that a person was Biblically baptized and active in a church of another denomination that does not provide a letter of transfer to FCBC.
- *Baptism by immersion is the Biblically accepted approach for membership into FCBC. Persons desiring to join FCBC who have received an alternative approach to immersion may request immersion by our church. There will be a clarifying class regarding church membership and service as a person enters into the church's circle.
- *Persons joining FCBC will be received by a church vote of acceptance at the end of a regular worship service.
