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#### **WORDS: "Abortion or Murder?"**

The obvious question related to the Abortion issue (Roe vs. Wade) is tied to the definition of life and when it begins? For a Christian that believes that the Bible provides answers, our standard of life is tied to the work of God in creation. Going back to the Old Testament is certainly one approach to look for definitions but it is just as easy for us to reflect on the New Testament description of Christ's birth.

It is difficult for me to fully grasp that my "so-called Christian nation" has compromised its value of human life to similar standards of an atheistic China. By avoiding the term "murder" in preference for the word "abortion" over the past 50 years, we have seen a generation of people become comfortable with our behavior of eliminating life as we see fit. Indeed, in the name of "women's rights" and health benefits do many find comfort justifying their stances toward murder as they disregard the fact that most abortions are done as an act of convenience and not medical necessity! I mention this only to say that my own mother was one who received medical advice toward an abortion and then rejected that thought due to her strong faith in the providence of God. Obviously, I am thankful for her faith commitment!

Mary, and her cousin Elizabeth, were pregnant at the same time. Unlike Mary (approx. 14 yrs old) who was to give birth to Jesus, Elizabeth was aged at the time that she gave birth to John the Baptist. The Sanctity of Life is a concept that is much more than just a theoretical idea created by man but relates to the work of God in the lives of humankind. In Luke 1:39-41 it says, "In those days Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a town in Judah, and she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit." The emphasis of these words was that John and Jesus were both "babies" in the wombs of their mothers. The mentioning of one baby responding to the existence of the other was a confirmation that God recognized them not as a lifeless fetus but as the babies that He had created. Do we really desire to discuss our continued right to commit murder in our country?
