WORDS: "Controversial is to be Expected"

Two weeks ago, the topic that I included in my "WORDS From a Pastor" brought an accurate comment from a brother who stated that my topic was controversial. His observation was correct. Anything these days seems to be controversial if we are speaking about something significant. My dear brother wasn't complaining about the topic entitled "Abortion or Murder" but was just pointing out that our society would find it questionable to bring up this sensitive issue in the way that I did. Even when reflecting on the birth of Jesus, many in our world would prefer not to consider that 50 years of legalized abortion doesn't make it anything that God would see as acceptable.

As I reflect on my mentor, Jesus, I have to recognize that he modeled a level of courage toward presenting "truth" that is hard for any of us to follow. The word "controversial" would have been an understatement to describe Christ. In Mark 11: 15–19, Jesus entered the temple and found people buying and selling by using the location as not more than a location for business matters so He acted decisively (and controversially) by removing those people in a very powerful way.

Mark 3: 1-6, Jesus healed a man's hand on the Sabbath and the Pharisees immediately responded by plotting how they might destroy Him! Controversy may well be what it is to follow Jesus as we are not here to impress people with our personal successes and fame but we serve to help others know what it is to be a follower of Jesus as their Lord!
