

What a great phone call came this morning to start my day! My god-daughter phoned with the news that she, and her husband, are expecting twins! These two new babies will join their current two siblings so Liu Yi Ting and her husband are looking at some exciting days ahead!

Growing up in ZhouNing County, Ningde-Fujian, as an "only child," the idea that Yi Ting and her husband will be making her parents the grandparents of such a large "crew" is amazing! Yi Ting's parents still live in her mountain hometown and will soon become the "stars in the community" where having two children would already be viewed as a large family.

Most of my friends, even from China, have no idea where ZhouNing is located. When serving as the Dean of the International Department of a small university (14,000) in Chongqing, I was privileged to work in reaching out to a number of students. With some of those students making decisions for Christ, Sue and I had the opportunity to visit some of their homes when they took their school breaks. Liu Yi Ting was one of those students and we still count her parents as our friends even to this day.

We live in a world of relationships and connections. I have not lived in the same city as this couple in over 10 years, and yet, the memories of our days together remain precious to me. May I suggest that we all need to more deeply treasure the persons that God places in our lives and rightly put forth the effort to stay in contact with those friends. It is never a waste of time to write or call another person and pray for them through your words of blessing. They, and you, are God's creation.
